To enter, you must either be **4 – 12 years old**, living in Tisbury and home-schooled, or in Primary School Year R-6 attending one of the participating Primary Schools*. Any form of hand drawn / handmade artwork (except photographs, digital or Al generated images) can be submitted. The poster must be your own work.
