Job Vacancy - Village Warden

Tisbury Parish Council is looking to appoint an enthusiastic and proactive Village Warden. This is a practical maintenance role which will contribute to ensuring that the parish is kept clean, safe and well-presented and Parish Council assets are maintained to a high standard.

Reporting to the Clerk to the Council, the successful applicant will carry out general maintenance duties, mainly outdoors, in the Council's play areas, including bin emptying, litter picking and strimming, reporting potholes and liaising with Wiltshire Highways as well as acting as the Flood Warden when required. The use of hand tools and equipment will be essential as will a good appreciation of health and safety.

This is a part-time post – 17 hours per week - with a salary range of £28,142 - £29,450 pro rata and 23 days holiday available to the successful candidate, who will be required to have a DBS certificate.
