- b. **Presentation of Requests for Small Grant Funding from Local Groups:**  
A total of 3 grants were submitted:
1. **Tisbury Memory Group** - contribution towards an event to be held on Wednesday 2nd July - £300
  2. **Tisbury Community Choir** - contribution towards the cost of putting on a "free concert" at Christmas - Music, licences, publicity and venue hire - £300
  3. **TisTalk** – contribution towards subscriptions to their web-platform, Buzzsprout, and audio editing software, Hindenburg, plus printing of promotional leaflets - £300

Councillor Davison declared a personal and non-pecuniary interest in the grant application for TisTalk.

Representatives of Tisbury Community Choir and TisTalk spoke in support of their grants. Each of the bids were discussed informally and those present

raised no objections to the bids and each will therefore go forward for approval at the June meeting.
